It is to inform that, Official Committee has prepared the new accreditation rules, 2025 with the guidance and consultation the Hon'ble Minister for Information and Public Relations & Housing and the final draft has been submitted to the Government for the perusal and issuing the new Guide lines for accreditation for journalists.

In the process of issuance of the new Accreditation Rules 2025 the proposals are in active consideration and the final orders are awaited from Government. Meanwhile the accreditations have been extended for a period of two months i.e., from 01.01.2025 to 28.02.2025 vide ref. 2nd cited. In view of the above circumstances, in the reference 3rd cited, Government have been requested to extend validity of the accreditation cards for further period of three months i.e., from 01.03.2025 to 31.05.2025 to avoid inconvenience to the working Journalists.

Therefore, all the DIPROs are instructed to take necessary action for extending existing accreditation cards validity for another period of 3 months temporarily i.e., from 01.03.2025 to 31.05.2025 or till the issue of new accreditation cards whichever is earlier to the existing accredited Journalists who are presently working, after obtaining the list from the concerned Heads of Organizations. In this connection a press note have to be issued accordingly by all concerned officer.
